- **DPW involvement in maintenance** – can they clear up Shore Drive from Pickle to Miller St, Central to Willow, Bay Ave trees
- **Flyer** – can we put into next Boro mailing, suggested trees for planting and maintenance guide [on Boro website now]
- **Tree Maintenance Private Property** – Confirming removal 10 Bayview by Huffenagel and behind 117 Highland Ave on Boro paper road by JCPL.
- **Tree Maintenance Borough Property** - Vets Park by Bay & Shrewsbury, Hufunagel removed. On Bay Ave from Spring St to Shrewsbury, many trees are dead possible over use of weed killer noted upon inspection. Also Vet's along Bay Ave some trees near wires, Christian to alert JCPL, they inspected and confirmed it was ok.
- **Tree Removal and Protection Ordinance** – Question came up as to how violations are handled. Here is that section of the ordinance. Please note any member of the Commission can file a complaint on behalf of the Borough. Chris will get more info on process of handling complaint and issue of summons with PD and report back.

22-1.10 Violations and Penalties.

a. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-5, any person, firm, association or corporation violating any section of this chapter, shall, upon conviction in the Municipal Court having jurisdiction, be subject to a fine not exceeding two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars or imprisonment in the County jail or in any place provided by the municipality for the detention of prisoners, for any term not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both, or community service and shall replace each tree destroyed or removed in violation of this section with a tree on accordance to a list provided by the Shade Tree Commission. Each tree destroyed or removed in violation of this section shall be considered a separate offense. **b. Any member of the Shade Tree Commission can file complaints.** (Ord. No. O-08-06 § 22-1.10)
