July is Cat Licensing Month

1. Local Ordinance requires that all cats be licensed and have a current tag affixed to collar or harness. All cats 6 months or older must be licensed. An increased fee of two (\$2.00) dollars per cat license shall be paid by all persons purchasing a cat license after September 1st or more than three months after such cat becomes six months of age.
2. All cat licenses expire on June 30 each year. Failure to renew a cat license may result in a court appearance.
3. Check rabies information. **State Statute requires that any rabies vaccine that expires before May 1st of the licensing year will require an updated vaccine prior to the issuance of a new license.** If there has been any change since last billing, be sure to enclose required certificate, which will be returned. If the cat is no longer in your possession or has passed, we are very sorry for your loss. Please indicate this to us so we can update our records.
4. Check neuter status. If you have not already qualified for a reduced license fee, you may do so only by enclosing a spay/neuter certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian.
5. License must be issued in the name of an adult member of the household.
6. Free Rabies Clinic – held usually in November. Please call borough hall at (732) 872-1224 for information.

Please come to borough hall at 42 Shore Drive to fill out a form or you can download a form from Highlands website at www.highlandsborough.org and mail it in with your payment to Cat Licensing, 42 Shore Drive, Highlands, NJ 07732. Spayed/Neutered cat licenses are \$18.00. Non-Spayed/Neutered cat licenses are \$21.00. Cash or check payment is accepted. Please make your check payable to "Borough of Highlands."
